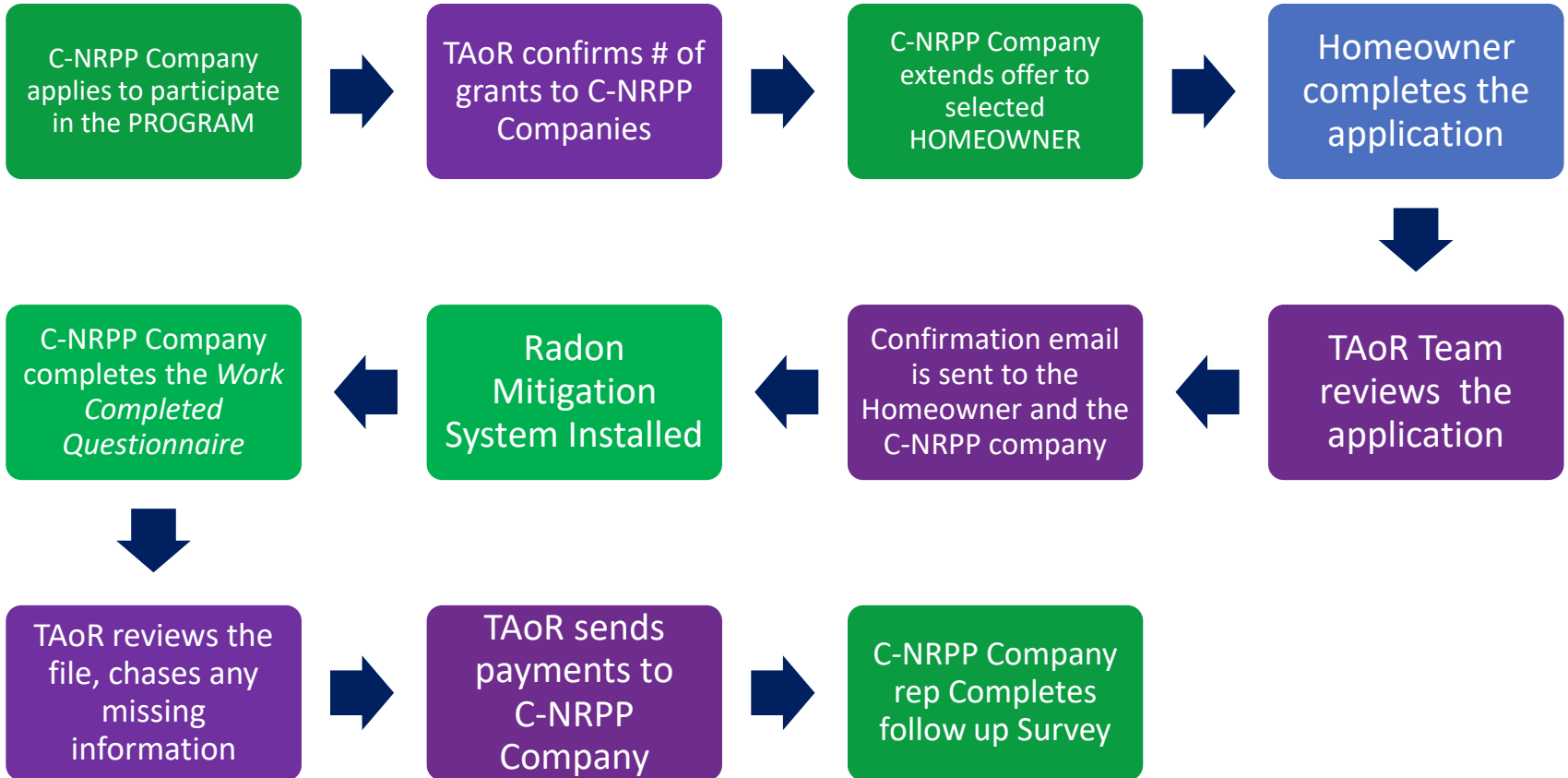
Grant Structure




\$500 per household

ASD radon mitigation systems installed in compliance with CGSB standard

1-2 Grants will be provided to C-NRPP Professionals only
(Based on # of companies participating in the program.)

- **residential** dwellings located within Canada
- 200 Bq/m³** or above based on a valid long-term radon test within the last 2 years*
- One grant per household.

Apply to Participate in Program

- All currently-certified C-NRPP Mitigation Professionals are eligible.
- Must complete this webinar and quiz
 - Company has developed their COVID-19 plan (four steps discussed during CARST's webinar)
 - Must be willing to reach out to 1 or more clients to offer mitigation grant
 - Installing ASD systems in compliance with the CGSB standard
 - Must be willing to provide feedback at the end of the project

Eligibility and Process of Application

HOMEOWNER APPLICATION:

The application is completed online and includes the following information:

- Homeowner's name, address, email and phone number
- Radon level with a copy of long-term radon test report, dated January 1, 2018 to present
- Written quote from a C-NRPP professional*** for intended mitigation work

Incomplete application forms will not be accepted.

Confirmation must be received prior to grants being paid out.

Requirements of C-NRPP Professionals

The *Work Completed Questionnaire* includes the following information:

- Invoice for work done, showing the \$500 grant discount
- Date of installation
- Post mitigation short-term radon test results, including duration and device used
- 3 Photos of installed system including the following: overall system installation, close-up of the U-Tube Manometer, and close-up of fan label
- Drawing scheme or written description of diagnostic testing completed
- Confirmation that a depressurization/back-drafting test was completed



Eligibility and Process of Application... fine print

*The reported test “end date” must be January 1, 2018 or more recent.

** Participants must submit a copy of a long-term (91 day or longer) radon test report issued by an C-NRPP approved laboratory or radon measurement professional indicating either that the reported radon level is above 200 Bq/m³, or that the reported radon level plus the reported margin of error (+/- %) is above 200 Bq/m³.

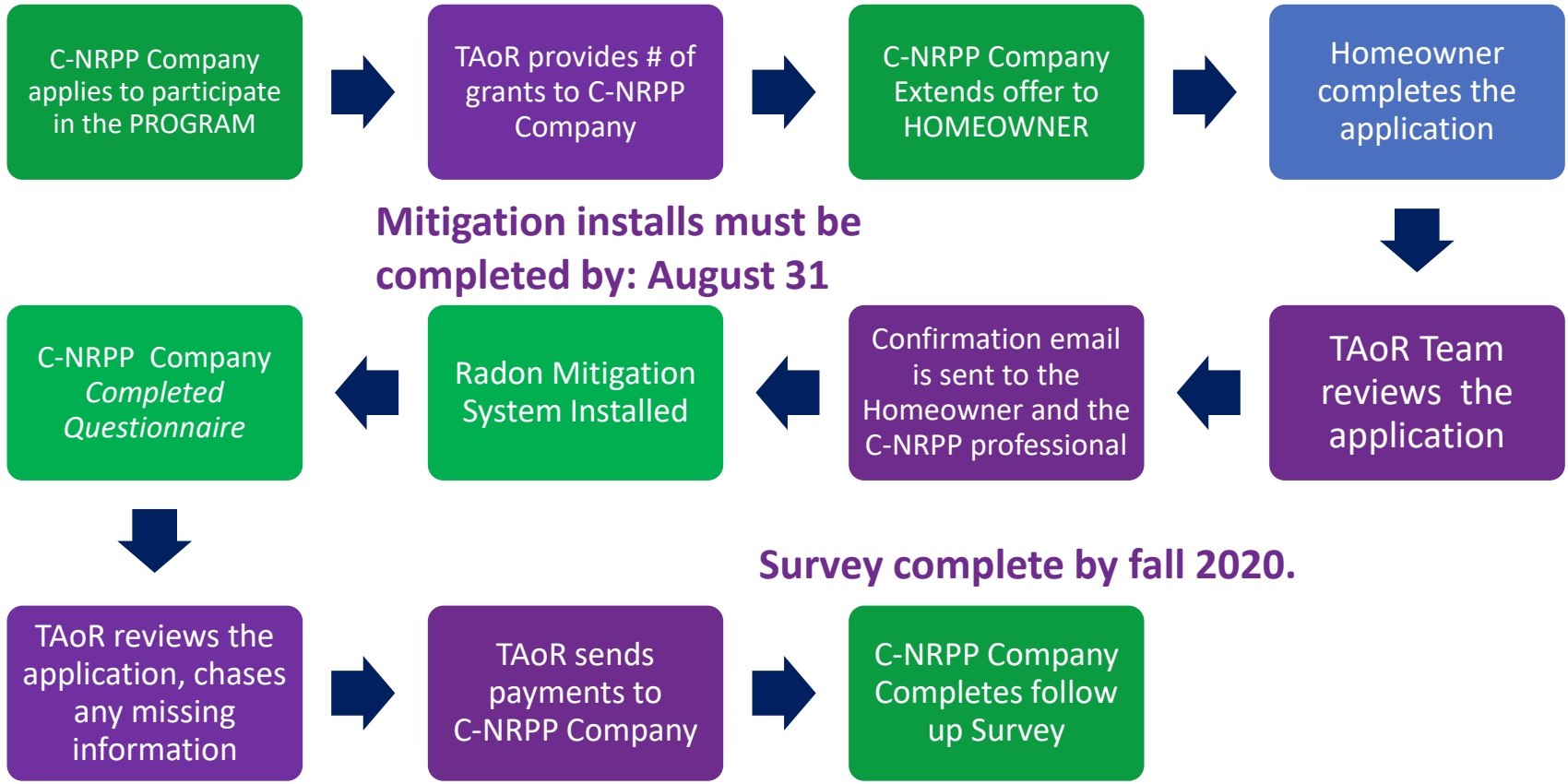
***Quote and Invoice must include the name and C-NRPP identification (ID) number of a C-NRPP Mitigation Professional who is listed at <https://c-nrpp.ca/find-a-professional/> as of the date indicated on the quote and who has completed *CARST's COVID-19 Getting Back to Radon Mitigation* webinar and quiz.
